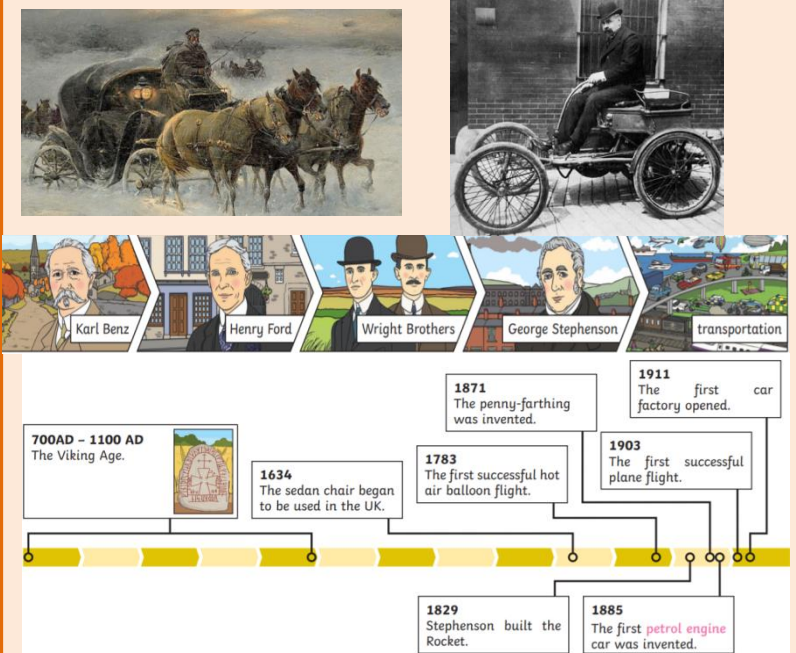
★ Star Vocabulary ★

Transport	Carrying people or goods from one place to another.
Travel	Moving from one place to another.
Steam Engine	Uses steam from boiling water to make it move.
Engine	The main part of the transport that makes it move.
Inventors	A person who comes up with a new idea.
Journey	Travelling from place to place.

Key Facts

- Transport can be through **land, air** or **water**.
- Land transport includes cars, trains, bicycles, scooters and walking.
- Water transport happens using ships, boats, submarines, yachts etc. It can happen over sea, rivers, canals and lakes.
- Air transport occurs using aeroplanes, jets and helicopters
- The Wright Brothers were the first people to successfully fly in a plane.
