## Star Vocabulary

**Minims:** a musical half note. It is played for half the duration of a whole note.

**Crotchet:** a musical note with the time value of one beat

**Quaver:** a musical note that lasts for half a beat. Two quavers last as long as one crotchet.

**Notation:** music notation are the symbols used in written music.

## Key Learning

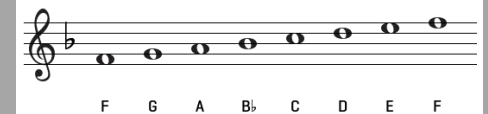
- To understand key and scale – F major – F, G, A, Bb, C, D, E, F
