The role of the Board of Trustees

The Academy's Board of Trustees is responsible for providing confident and strategic leadership, and creating robust accountability, oversight and assurance for the school's educational and financial performance. The board is passionate about education and committed to continuous school improvement to ensure the best possible outcomes for our pupils.

The role of a parent trustee

As a parent trustee, you'll work with the board to ensure it effectively carries out the duties referred to above. You'll also play a vital role in ensuring that the board is connected with, and is aware of the views of, parents and the local community.

To be a parent trustee you should have:

- A strong commitment to the role and to improving outcomes for children
- Good inter-personal skills, curiosity, and a willingness to learn and develop new skills
- The specific skills required to ensure the Board of Trustees delivers effective governance

Expectations of trustees

- Attendance at meetings: The Full Board meets four times a year with meetings commencing at 4.15pm and usually ending by 6pm, although they may finish later on occasions. Recently these have been carried out on Zoom but it is hoped that this will move to face to face meetings over the coming months.
- There are also sub committees which meet between two and four times per year in addition to the Full Board.
- Maintaining confidentiality
- Committing to training
- Visiting the school
