# **Guidance for Secondary Pupils during COVID-19**

This guidance is a document to provide clarity regarding how you should behave during the COVID-19 pandemic to reduce the risk to yourselves, the academy and our wider community. Hand sanitisers are available in every classroom and you will be expected to sanitise / wash your hands regularly and maintain social distancing.

Please ensure you follow these guidelines.

# Before entering the academy

- Before leaving home wash your hands and avoid touching your face, mouth and eyes
- The most preferable way for you to come to school is to walk, cycle or be escorted by car. However, should this not be possible and you will be using public transport avoid peak times (before 8.15am and after 4pm) Please make sure you are aware of the start and finish time for your year group.
- If you are wearing PPE when you are about to enter the academy, please dispose of it in the lidded bins outside or place in your bag and wash your hands.
- Face coverings are not recommended for use in schools by the government. However, should you feel the need to use a face covering when in the academy, then you must apply a new mask / covering after washing your hands when you enter the academy.

## On entering the academy

- You will be directed to sanitise / wash your hands for 20 seconds.
- Maintain social distancing.
- When sat at a desk in the classroom, use the cleaning materials provided to wipe your workspace.

## During the academy day

Movement around the academy will be restricted. You will be expected to observe social
distancing measures and good respiratory and hand hygiene. Remember you have a direct
influence on how this virus spreads and need to protect, yourself, your families and other
students and staff within the academy. At regular points, throughout the day, you will be
directed to sanitise / wash your hands including during any break in lessons and you will be
reminded to use hand sanitiser as you enter and leave each room.

If you begin to display symptoms of COVID-19 (a continuous cough, loss of smell and taste, fever) you must tell a member of staff who will direct you straight to the medical room where you should knock and wait outside. The medical team will take you through what will happen next.

#### Behaviour

The academy Behaviour Policy (Appendix F) has been amended to protect our academy community and failure to follow this guidance will lead to sanctions with escalating consequences including; removal from the classroom to work in isolation and being refused the opportunity to be in the academy.

## Before leaving the academy

- Before leaving the academy you will wash your hands and avoid touching your face, mouth and eyes.
- Should you need to wear a face mask or gloves for your journey from the academy, please put this on once you have left the academy.
