

## **Guidance for KS1 and Nursery pupils during COVID-19**

Welcome back! We are so pleased you are able to return to the new academic year. However, some things will be different due to COVID-19 but your teacher will explain this all to you. We want to make sure that you and everyone in our school is happy, safe and healthy. So, we need you to do the following:

### ***Before coming to school:***

- Before leaving home wash your hands for at least 20 seconds and avoid touching your face, mouth and eyes.
- You may be starting school at a slightly different time. This will be communicated to your family.

### ***At your playground:***

- You will be dropped at school by one parent / carer and will be met by an adult / your teacher who will be ready to take you to your class.
- You will then say goodbye to your family member / carer until they return to collect you.
- On the way to your classroom, you will be directed to wash / sanitise your hands.

### ***During the school day:***

- Always listen carefully to the instructions of all the adults looking after you.
- You will be asked to sanitise / wash your hands more regularly throughout the day.
- You will be shown where to sit in the classroom and that will be your place to sit while you are at school.
- You will be reminded by your teachers to keep a good space between you and others at all times. Try to remember too!

- If you feel unwell, tell your teacher straight away

***Before going home:***

- Before going home wash your hands for at least 20 seconds and avoid touching your face, mouth and eyes
- Your teacher will take you to meet your parents/carers at the allotted time.

**Remember, if you are worried about anything during the school day, you must tell an adult.**
