Literacy

We will look at a range of stories with a Superhero theme including Supertato, Michael Recycle and Superworm. We will also be continuing Read Write Inc where the children will be learning their sounds and using them to write words. We are going to begin to look at the high frequency words and begin to get the children used to them in their work.

Maths

We will be focusing on Shape, Space and Measure. Specifically, 3D shapes and their properties, measuring (weight, height, length). We will also continue our learning journey with Numbers this term focusing on addition, subtraction and number bonds to 10. We will be continuing with the Maths Passport Scheme within our school to work on our number skills as well as having opportunities to work on our mental maths skills.

Physical Development

We will be continuing our weekly PE sessions. We are also going to have superhero training days where the children will learn all about keeping their body healthy.

Personal Social and Emotional Development

During 'Circle Time' as a class we discuss any matters that have arisen during the week and work towards resolving these. We promote and encourage positive behaviour and caring and respectful ethos.
