Star Vocabulary Symbolism Late nineteenthcentury movement, that suggested ideas through symbols and emphasised the meaning behind the forms, lines, shapes, and colours gilding to cover something with gold leaf or gold paint frieze a long stretch of painted, sculpted or even calligraphic decoration. normally placed above eye-level

Frida Kahlo 1907-1954



- -Gustav Klimt was an Austrian symbolist painter born in 1862.
- -He was one of the most prominent members of the Vienna Secession movement.
- -His major works include paintings, murals, sketches, and other art objects.
- -In 1918, Klimt died of influenza in Vienna.
