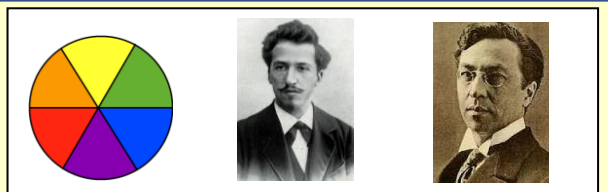


Year 1 Colour Creations Knowledge Organiser

Star Vocabulary	
Primary Colours	Colours that can be mixed together to create all the other colours. Primary colours are red, blue and yellow.
Secondary Colours	These are all the other colours that are made from mixing the primary colours.
Shade	Colours can have shades that are darker or lighter. We can make a different shade by adding white or black to a colour.
Abstract paintings	Paintings that show ideas more than pictures. They are common in Expressionist art.
Collage	An artwork made by sticking different materials, like paper and photos, together.


Explore pattern and colour in African art




Colours exist all around us. There are primary colours, which can be mixed to make secondary colours. Mixing white or black into a colour can also create different shades.

Different artists have used colours in their art to show ideas and feelings. Expressionists Piet Mondrian and Wassily Kandinsky are artists who created abstract artwork by using bright colours.


