

Year 1 Curriculum Newsletter Autumn Term 2022



Welcome back! We hope you enjoyed your break. Below is a selection of the areas that your child will be studying over the next term.

Class texts

For our end of day read we will be reading a selection of fiction stories from our book corner. We will be reading a variety of fairy-tale and superhero stories.

RWI

This term we will be teaching the children Set 1 and Set 2 phonic sounds. They will be practising to read alien words and real words during their daily RWI lessons. Remember to look out for the RWI links that will be posted each week so that you can continue to support your child.

Science

Our first topic this term is all about the 'Human Body', where we will explore the 5 senses. We will be carrying out a range of experiments to put our 5 senses to the test.

Geography

Over the term we will be learning all about the 4 seasons. We will be finding out what happens as the seasons change and why. Children will be discussing the different types of clothing worn during the seasons and the weather patterns.

PSHCE

PSHCE is taught through daily reflections, assemblies and PSHCE days. This term the children will be focusing on their health and well-being.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on number and place value. The children will be learning to order numbers correctly from 1-20 and beyond, say what one more and one less than a number is, recognise quantity and continue to consolidate their number knowledge.

English

This term we will be focusing on oracy and sentence composition. We will then read and discuss The Little Red Riding Hood and write our own character description using adjectives.

History

This term, we will be beginning to understand the concept of the past. We will begin to use vocabulary like before, after and last week etc. We will also use timelines and family trees.

Computing

This half term we will be finding out the importance of staying safe online. Should we share passwords and usernames? Do we give out our personal details?

The children will be completing a variety of activities on Purple Mash.

RE

Initially, we will be looking at the idea of a belief and what it means. The children will explore a variety of creation stories and think about what Christians and Jewish people believe.

REMINDER

- **Read** every day for 20 minutes at least and ensure an adult signs their reading record everyday once the child has written a sentence.
- Practise their **spellings** ready for their test each Monday.
- **Homework** is sent home on Fridays and must be returned on or before the following Wednesday.
- PE – **Squirrel class**- Wednesday & Thursday, **Dove class**- Wednesday and Thursday, **Starfish class**- Tuesday & Wednesday. The children must come to school in their PE kit on these days.
