**Collateral damage:** injury or other damage inflicted that is an unintended result of a military operation

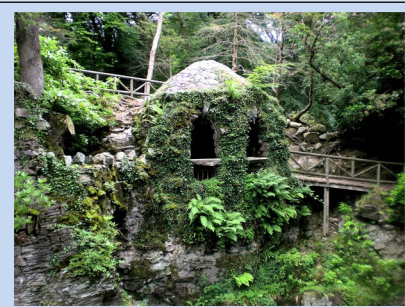
**Conspicuous:** noticeable
