Key Vocabulary

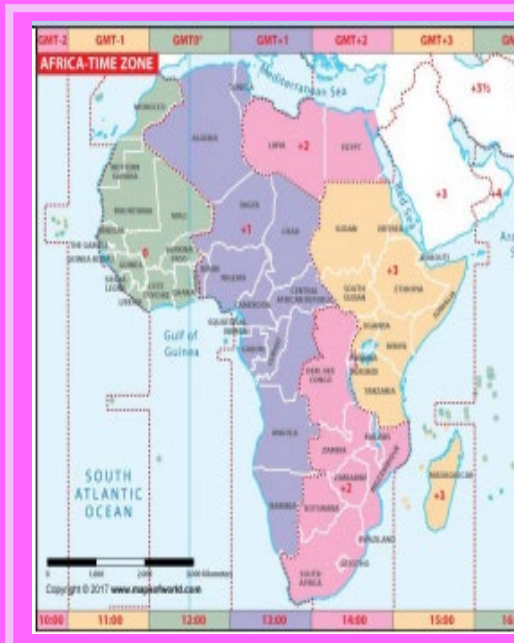
city	a large town . London is a city
diverse	If a group or range of things is diverse, it is made up of a wide variety of things.
Natural resource	Resources that exist or occur in nature and are not made or caused by people (e.g. wind, water, oil, metals).
Greenwich Mean Time(GMT)	The standard time in Great Britain which is used to calculate the time in the rest of the world.
Savanna	Open grasslands, usually with scattered bushes or trees
Semi-arid	Characterized by little rainfall and scrubby vegetation
human features	features of land that have been impacted by human activity
plateau	A large area of high and fairly flat land..
physical features	natural features of land
weather	the condition of the atmosphere in one area at a particular time
Vegetation	Plants, trees, and flowers
