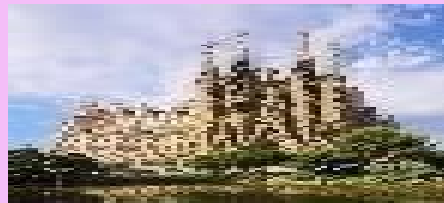


## Key Vocabulary

city	a large <b>town</b> . London is a <b>city</b>
climate	the general weather conditions that are typical of a place
coastal	an area of land close to the sea
compass	main points of a compass: north, south, east, west
continent	a very large area of land that consists of many <b>countries</b> . Europe is a <b>continent</b> .
country	an area of land that is controlled by its own government.
human features	features of land that have been impacted by human activity
landscape	everything you can see when you look across an area of land, including hills, rivers, buildings, trees, and plants.
physical features	natural features of land
weather	the condition of the atmosphere in one area at a particular time

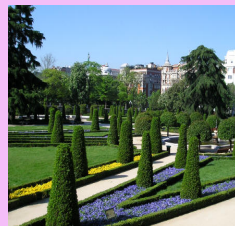

Contrast countries in different continents, e.g. Africa and America

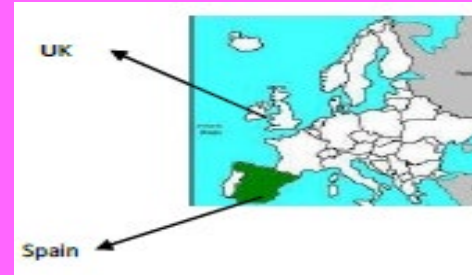


### Human Features
