Rainforest	One of the earth oldest ecosystem
Vegetation	Ground that is covered by plants.
Amazon river	The river that flows through Brazil. It is 4,000 miles long.
Grassland	A large open area covered with grass especially one for grazing.
Canopy	The canopy is made up of overlapping branches and leaves of rainforest tree.
physical features	natural features of land
weather	the condition of the atmosphere in one area at a particular time
Subtropical grassland	Grassland that are warm all year round with a established rainy and dry season

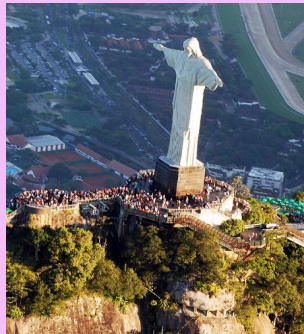
