miniatures	Small paintings that are used for books and albums. They were often painted on cloth or paper.
murals	Largescale wall paintings that take a long time to complete.
Henna	A reddish-brown dye made from the powdered leaves of a tropical shrub, used to colour the hair and decorate the body.
Block printing technique	Block printing is the process of printing patterns by means of engraved wooden blocks.



- Indian paintings styles are varied and date back to the 17<sup>th</sup> Century.
- The earliest Indian paintings were painted onto rock walls in caves. The Bhimbetka rock shelters have cave paintings that are approximately 30,000 years old.
- Indian painting styles have developed throughout the centuries. Each style incorporates the Indian culture, traditions and religious beliefs.

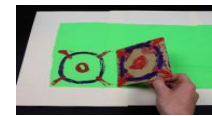
