

<u>Star Vocabulary</u>	
Ignorance	lack of knowledge or information
Suffering	Suffering is the bearing and undergoing of pain or distress.
<u>intrinsic</u>	belonging naturally; essential.
<u>fitrah</u>	is the state of purity and innocence Muslims believe all humans to be born with
<u>Tenakh</u>	an acronym referring to the traditional Jewish division of the Bible into Torah
<u>Rahit</u> <u>Maryada</u>	summarises the main teachings of the Gurus and outline the Sikh way of life.
<u>Karma</u>	the universal causal law by which good or bad actions determine the future modes of an individual's existence.
<u>martyrdom</u>	the death or suffering of a martyr.
