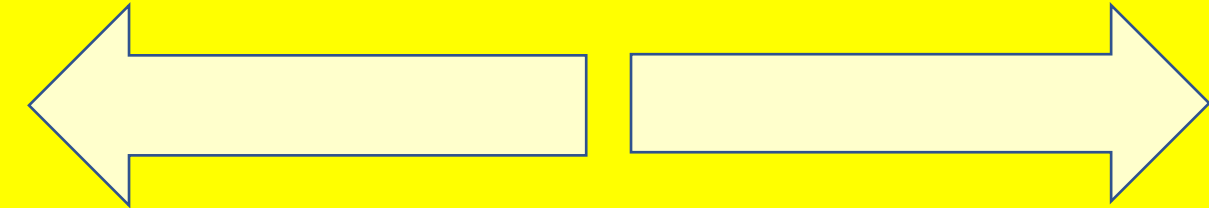


Knowledge Organiser: Chinese Art: Year 5

Star Vocabulary	
dynasty	rulers who belong to the same royal family for generations
linear	a system of creating an illusion of depth on a flat surface.
Calligraphy	decorative handwriting or handwritten lettering
Terracotta	a type of fired clay, typically of a brownish-red colour and unglazed, used as an ornamental building material and in modelling.




-One area where the Ancient Chinese had a profound effect during their time and in modern times is in the Arts.


