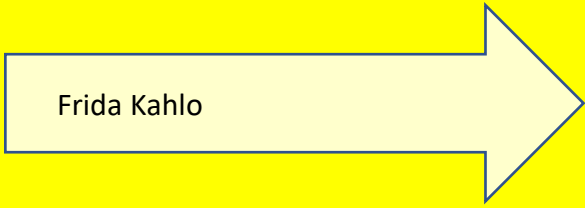




Knowledge Organiser: Sonia Delaunay: Year 4

Star Vocabulary	
Abstract art	Abstract art is modern art which does not represent images of our everyday world. It has colour, lines and shapes (form), but they are not intended to represent objects or living things.
Orphism	Orphism was an abstract, cubist influenced painting style developed by Robert and Sonia Delaunay around 1912. Robert Delaunay.
geometric	shapes made out of points and lines including the triangle, square, and circle. to create them.
retrospective	An exhibition showing the development of an artist's work over a period of time.



- Sonia Delaunay was an artist and designer from Ukraine.

-She was born November 14, 1885, in Ukraine and died December 5, 1979, in Paris.

-She co-founded Orphism alongside her husband Robert and after he passed away, she didn't make art for 10 years.

-She was the first female living artist to have a retrospective at the Louvre.

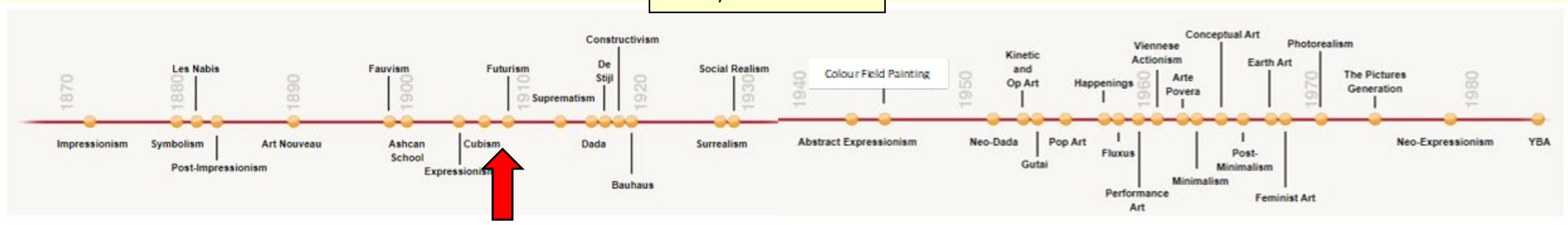
