Seasons	One of the four periods of the year which have different weather and hours of daylight
Sunny	The sun is shining brightly
cloudy	There are a lot of clouds in the sky
foggy	Low-lying cloud, making it hard to see
stormy	Thunder and lightning
snowy	Soft, white pieces of frozen water that fall to the ground from the sky in cold weather
hail	Hard pieces of frozen water that fall to the ground from the sky in cold weather
windy	The air is moving and blowing
temperature	The degree or intensity of heat present
