What does it mean to be a member of the Jewish community?

Star Vocabulary

Judaism	The name of the religion that Jewish people follow and believe in.
Community	A group of people who live or work together in the same area, or who have something important in common.
Torah	A very important text for Jewish people which refers to the first five books of the Jewish Bible, or Books of Moses.
Synagogue	A building where Jewish people go to worship.
Ritual	A set of actions people do, usually at a set time or for a certain reason.
Shabbat	The Jewish day of rest. This is the most important day in the week which begins on Friday and ends Saturday at sundown.
Rabbi	A Jewish religious leader who is usually in charge of a synagogue.
