### Sticky Facts

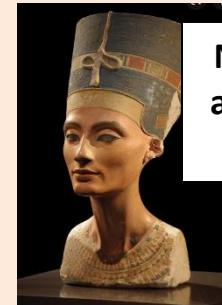
- Monarchs used to make important decisions for their country.
