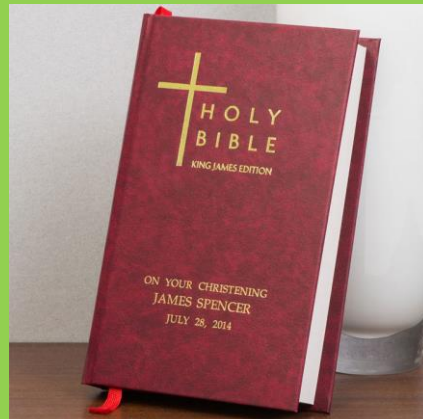

Baptism



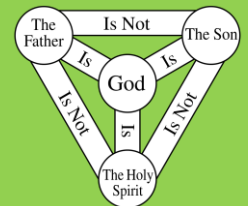
The holy book
