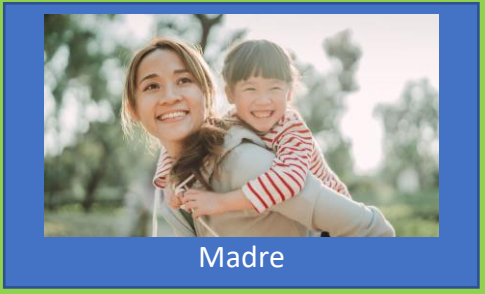
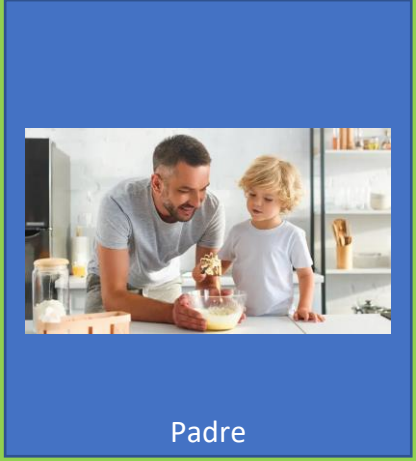


**Do I know how to say in Spanish all my family members?**
