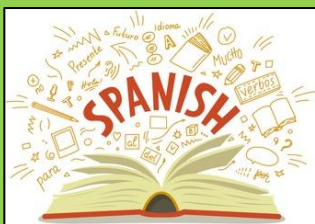


Year 3 Autumn 2 Spanish Knowledge Organiser
