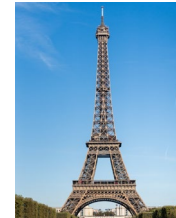
## Star Vocabulary

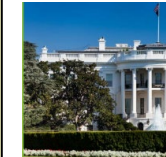

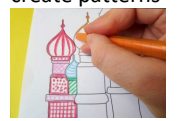


## Skills Needed:

1. Outline St Basil's Cathedral



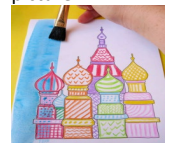
2. Use wax crayons to create patterns
