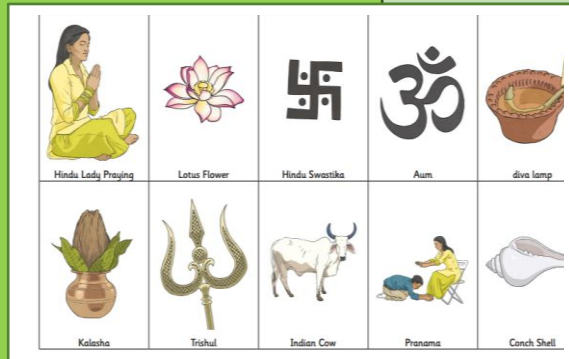

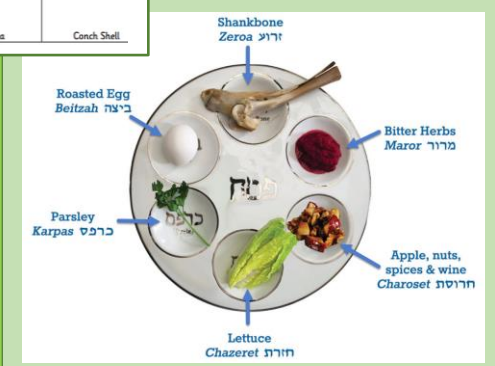
Star Vocabulary

Symbol	A symbol is a mark, sign, or word that indicates, signifies, or is understood as representing an idea, object, or relationship
artefact	An object made by a human being, typically one of cultural or historical interest.
Represent	When something shows the meaning of a concept/idea/object or what something stands for.
Gestures	a movement of part of the body, especially a hand or the head, to express an idea or meaning.
Offerings	a thing offered, especially as a gift or contribution

Facts

- You need to know the meaning of symbols to understand them.
- The olive branch and the dove are both symbols of peace and reconciliation.
- The rainbow is a symbolism of God's faithfulness.
- The seder plate includes lots of symbols for Jews. Some of these symbols represent the idea of slavery and being in a rush to escape slavery.
- Christians believe that Jesus is a metaphor for light- the change from living in the darkness of sin to the light of freedom and forgiveness.
- Religious beliefs and ideas can be experienced in different forms.
- In Islam, beliefs and ideas are experienced not in images but in the form of prayer.
