

# Year 1 Addition and Subtraction (2) Knowledge Organiser



## ★ Star Vocabulary ★

<b>Subtract</b>	Taking an amount away
<b>Plus +</b>	When you add two or more amounts together
<b>Add +</b>	Combining amounts together.
<b>Altogether +</b>	capable of producing desired results with little or no waste
<b>Fact Family</b>	A collection of related addition and subtraction facts involving the same numbers
<b>Number Sentence</b>	sentence written in numerals, using mathematical symbols
<b>Equals =</b>	The total amount

Add and subtract numbers to 10 including number bonds.

$7 + 3 = 10$

$17 + 3 = 20$

recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.

We will need some maths words. Which words do you already know?

add    altogether  
ones    tens  
number bonds    part-whole

We can still use this and this to help us. What is  $12 + 3$ ?

## Sentence Stems

How many bonds can I make if

10 is a whole?

What is the largest/smallest number?

Can you write a fact family for \_\_\_?

If \_\_\_ is the whole and \_\_\_ is a part, what is the missing part?

Misconceptions: Why?  
 $12 + 5 = 18$

INCORRECT jump on a number line (forward for subtraction, backwards for addition or more than one jump per number)
