Star Vocabulary

Crotchet: a musical note with the time value of one beat

Quaver: a musical note that lasts for half a beat. Two quavers last as long as one crotchet.

Paired quavers: two quavers joined together

Dynamics: how quietly or loudly a piece of music should be played.


Bar: a small segment of music that holds a certain number of beats.
