Key C Major, find the beat and have fun with the beat

Key and scale - G major - G A B C D E F# G. Recognise and move to a steady beat in a 2/4 metre

## Star Vocabulary

**Crotchet:** a musical note with the time value of one beat

**Quaver:** a musical note that lasts for half a beat. Two quavers last as long as one crotchet.

**Paired quavers:** two quavers joined together

**Dynamics:** how quietly or loudly a piece of music should be played.

**Bar:** a small segment of music that holds a certain number of beats.

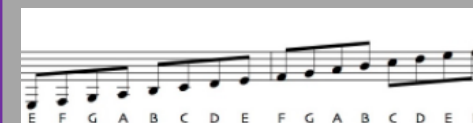
## Key Learning
