



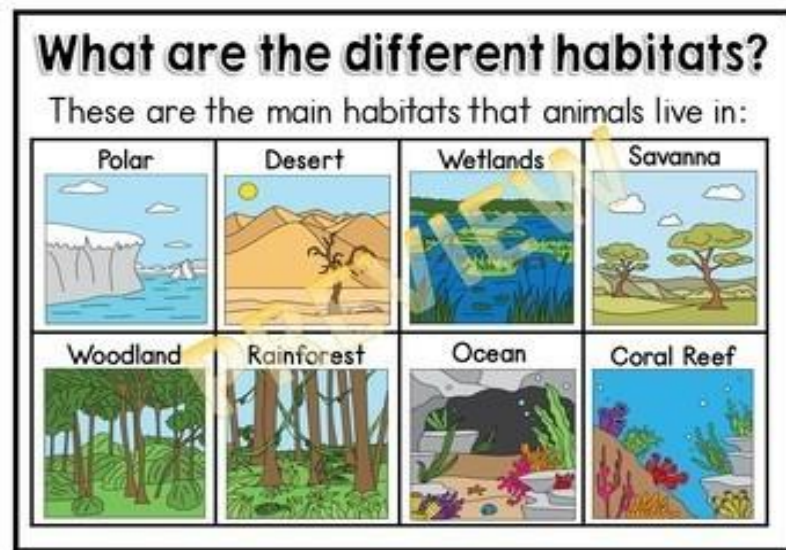

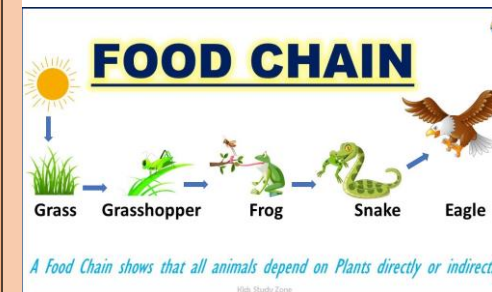
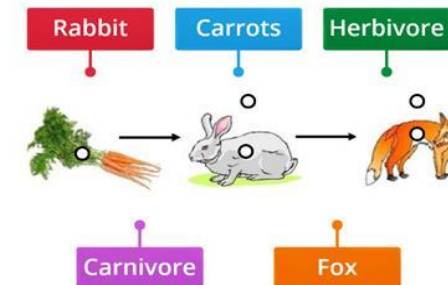
habitat	Your habitat is the environment you are accustomed to living in.
food chain	The term food chain describes the order in which organisms, or living things, depend on each other for food.
Predator	A predator is an animal that hunts, kills and eats other animals for food.
Microhabitat	A microhabitat is a very small part of a habitat, such as a clump of grass or a space between rocks.
Adaptation	the action or process of adapting or being adapted
Living	Not dead.
