Our children of critical workers are the children whose parents work in the following areas:

- The NHS,
- Social Care,
- Education support staff,
- · Police and law enforcement,
- National Crime Agency,
- Waste Disposal,
- Oil, gas, electricity, and water services

Parents who are Critical Workers, will need to bring their children into the primary reception area and show their ID badge which they have for their place of work to Kim to confirm their status as a Critical Worker.

Our vulnerable children include those who:

- Have a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan, or
- Have an Education, Health, Care Plan (EHCP), or
- Have an allocated social worker or social care involvement, or
- Are a Looked After Child (LAC), or
- Has recognised emotional/mental health issues

Our vulnerable children will be met in the reception area by Julie, or Fiona. School will be closed to our other children with schoolwork for the day being uploaded to Class DoJo for Nursery and Reception pupils and uploaded to Classcharts for Years 1-6 pupils. All families have their personalised logins for Class DoJo and Classcharts.

If your child falls into the Critical Worker or Vulnerable child category and **you are going to** send them into school on Wednesday 15 March 2023 and Thursday 16 March 2023 could

you please send an email to adminp@alecreedacademy.co.uk by Friday 10th March with your child's name and class written clearly on the email and say that your child will be attending school on Wednesday 15 March 2023 and Thursday 16 March 2023 based on the 'Critical Worker' or 'Vulnerable child' category. This will help us with all of the planning that needs to be in place.
