Reducing Stress

We are fortunate that we have our own full time counsellor in the academy but I share the following link [Kooth mental health support | Ealing Grid for Learning \(egfl.org.uk\)](https://www.egfl.org.uk) which you may find useful. Kooth is an NHS Commissioned digital mental health service that provides free, immediate, online counselling every day until 10pm with no waiting lists. It is available to young people aged 11-25 [Video about Kooth](#) and the website is available to access 24/7, with online counsellors available from 12-10pm weekdays and 6-10pm at the weekend.

Identity Theft

It is important to remember that personal information in the wrong hands can be just as valuable as money and personal banking information can enable fraudsters to take out financial products and/or services in an innocent person's name, leaving them liable for any payments due. Sadly, social media enables anyone to pretend to be anyone they want to be online. Fraudsters are highly trained which means they can be very convincing. In recent weeks there have been cases where children in Ealing have been befriended by fraudsters on social media claiming they can help people to make 'easy money' or 'quick cash'. What may initially be perceived as a good opportunity quickly turn sour when they are persuaded to provide banking details or other personal information. I encourage you to talk to your children about online safety and to use privacy settings across social media platforms to manage your digital footprint and secure email and social media accounts. Each of which have facilities where you can block and report unwanted messages or untoward behaviour.

Term Dates

The term dates for the next academic year are now confirmed and are on display on the academy website. [Alec Reed Academy Term Dates](#) I bring your attention to one change from the original draft dates which is the addition of a Professional Development Day on Monday 31st October 2022. Pupils will not be expected in school on that day. It is really important that you take note of these dates and avoid taking any term time holidays. I remind you that I am not able to approve any request, except in the most extreme circumstances, and only then with supporting evidence. This is in response to direct guidance from the Government as they have a very clear expectation regarding attendance at school. I share with you a fact regarding the impact of attendance on student academic outcomes and employability.

The average student who is in school at least 95% of the time has a 74.5% chance of getting 5 or more GCSE's at Grade 5 or better.

And will earn on average 41% MORE money than.....

The average student who misses 20 days or more in a year has only a 26.7% chance of getting 5 or more GCSE's at Grade 5 or better.
